To accompany the petition of William J. Bullock and others that the city of New Bedford be authorized to establish an ice plant. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Establishment and Maintenance of an Ice Plant by the City of New Bedford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of New Bedford is hereby
2 authorized to construct and to maintain an ice plant
3 and to supply the inhabitants of the city with ice
4 at such prices as may be fixed from time to time by
5 the city council, with the approval of the mayor.
6 For this purpose the city may take land and build-
7 ings by right of eminent domain, or may purchase
8 the same, and may construct and maintain thereon
9 such buildings and other works as may be necessary,
10 and may take ice from the reservoirs maintained by
11 the city for supplying the inhabitants with water.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of constructing an
2 ice plant and equipping the same and of purchasing
3 land and buildings therefor, the city may issue
4 bonds to an amount not exceeding thou-
5 sand dollars, at such times and upon such terms as
6 may be determined by the city council with the ap-
7 proval of the mayor, but no bond issued under au-
8 thority hereof shall run for a term exceeding
9 years.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
