## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

To establish the Salary of Edward L. Burdakin as Assistant Register of Deeds for the County of Norfolk.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Edward L. Burdakin, assistant regis-  
2 ter of deeds for the county of Norfolk, shall receive  
3 an annual salary of three thousand dollars, to be so  
4 allowed from the first day of January in the year  
5 nineteen hundred and fourteen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
