said section seventeen; provided, however, that the number of seasonal licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises authorized for said town to grant under the provisions of said section seventeen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight shall be reduced by one such license.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 270. AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITIONS OF SECRETARY AND CLERK IN THE OFFICE OF THE TOWN CLERK AND ACCOUNTANT OF THE TOWN OF NORWOOD FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The positions of secretary and clerk in the office of the town clerk and accountant of the town of Norwood shall not be subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the civil service status of any person employed in the position of secretary or clerk in the office of the town clerk and accountant of the town of Norwood on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 271. AN ACT DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE OVER INTERSTATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 495 IN THE CITY OF TAUNTON AS THE HONORABLE RUDOLPH H. DeSILVA MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately designate the bridge over interstate highway route 495 in the city of Taunton as the Honorable Rudolph H. DeSilva memorial bridge, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience. _____
