

SENATE No. 340

To accompany the petition of George T. Daly that the employment of non-residents during strikes be prohibited. Labor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Employment of Non-Residents during
Strikes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Whenever a strike occurs in any city
2 or town it shall be unlawful to import or employ
3 professional strike breakers from any other city,
4 town or place to take the positions of the strikers.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of the provisions of this act
2 shall be punished by fine or imprisonment at the dis-
3 cretion of the court.
