

SENATE No. 343

To accompany the petition of Thomas J. Gorman and others that the duties and powers of the messenger of the municipal court of the city of Boston be increased. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To increase the Duties and Powers of the Messenger of the Municipal Court of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and
2 ninety-two of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 six is amended in the first line by striking out all after
4 the word "Boston", and inserting the words:— who
5 shall also act as clerk to the justices of said court, and
6 be appointed by said justices or a majority of them, who
7 shall fix the annual salary of said messenger and clerk,
8 not to exceed twenty-five hundred dollars, to be paid by
9 the county of Suffolk,— so as to read as follows:—
10 *Section 1.* There shall be a messenger of the municipal

11 court of the city of Boston, who shall also act as clerk
 12 to the justices of said court, and be appointed by said
 13 justices or a majority of them, who shall also fix the
 14 annual salary of said messenger and clerk, not to exceed
 15 twenty-five hundred dollars, to be paid by the county of
 16 Suffolk.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
