

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 301, 302.

Notwithstanding any provision of the revised ordinances of the city of Chelsea or any other ordinance, general or special law to the contrary, the tenure of office of John J. Zimini as civil defense director of the city of Chelsea shall be unlimited but he may be removed for just cause in accordance with the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

Chap. 301. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO REORGANIZE ITS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 56 of the acts of 1957 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- No person shall serve on the board who holds an elective or appointive office in the town other than that of town meeting member, unless otherwise voted at the town meeting.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 56 is hereby further amended by striking out section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 3. The board of public works shall establish and supervise a department of public works which shall consist of a sewer division, a water division, a highway division, a sanitation division, an engineering division, and a park division, maintenance and construction only, or any combination of such divisions, as the board may deem appropriate.

Chap. 302. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF OXFORD TO GRANT AN EASEMENT TO WORCESTER COUNTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The town of Oxford is hereby authorized to grant to Worcester county for highway purposes, an easement over certain land of said town, now dedicated for use as a dump, located in said town and bounded and described as follows:
