## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

To provide for Uniforms for the Court Officers of the Municipal and District Courts of the County of Suffolk.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The officers in attendance at the municipal  
2 and district courts of the county of Suffolk shall, while on  
3 duty in said courts, wear uniforms to be designated by  
4 the justices of said courts, and for such uniforms shall be  
5 allowed and paid by the county of Suffolk the sum of one  
6 hundred dollars each annually in addition to their salaries  
7 as such officers.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
