

SENATE No. 557

To accompany the petition of C. Augustus Norwood that certain towns and districts be authorized to submit for acceptance to the voters the act to provide for compensating certain public employees for injuries sustained in the course of their employment. Joint Judiciary.

AN ACT

To authorize Certain Towns and Districts to submit for Acceptance to the Voters of such Towns and Districts an Act to provide for Compensating Certain Public Employees for Injuries sustained in the Course of their Employment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Towns and districts which have an annual
2 meeting of the legal voters and which, for any cause,
3 failed to submit chapter eight hundred and seven of the
4 acts of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, being
5 "An act to provide for compensating certain public em-
6 ployees for injuries sustained in the course of their em-
7 ployment", for acceptance to the voters of the town or

8 district at the next annual meeting after the passage of
9 said act, may submit said act for acceptance by the legal
10 voters of the town or district at the annual meeting in
11 the year nineteen hundred and fifteen, and such submis-
12 sion and the vote thereon shall have the same effect as
13 if the act had been submitted at the next annual meeting
14 of the town or district after the passage of said act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
