

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 346, 347.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Wareham is hereby authorized to issue to Ernest J. Rogers and Marie H. Rogers d/b/a E.J.'s Package Store a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section seventeen; provided, that the number of seasonal licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises authorized for said town to grant under the provisions of said section seventeen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight is reduced by one such license.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 346. AN ACT AUTHORIZING ROGER TRAHAN TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR FIREFIGHTER IN THE TOWN OF FRANKLIN, NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule regulating the maximum age of applicants for appointment as a firefighter, Roger Trahan shall be eligible to take the next open competitive examination for the position of firefighter in the town of Franklin, and provided he meets all other requirements, he shall be eligible for certification and appointment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 347. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING AND KEEPING OF DOGS IN THE TOWN OF BREWSTER.
