

Bill accompanying the petition of Arthur F. Hayden for clerical assistance for the probation officer of the municipal court of the Roxbury district of the city of Boston. Public Service. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

To provide for Clerical Assistance for the Probation Officer of the Municipal Court of the Roxbury District of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The municipal court of the Roxbury district of the city
2 of Boston may employ such clerical assistance as it may
3 deem necessary for the keeping, indexing and consolida-
4 tion of the records required to be kept in said court under
5 the provisions of section forty of chapter two hundred
6 and twelve and section eighty-four of chapter two hun-
7 dred and seventeen of the Revised Laws, and for such
8 other work in connection with its probation service as
9 the said court shall determine.

10 A sum not exceeding twelve hundred dollars may be
11 appropriated annually by the county commissioners of
12 the county of Suffolk for said clerical assistance, the same
13 to be paid by the treasurer of said county upon vouchers
14 approved by the justice of said court.
