

Bill accompanying the petition of John F. McCarthy relative to retaining on the civil service list the names of certain persons suspended or discharged for no fault of their own. Public Service. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Civil Service List.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A person employed by the commonwealth
2 or by any county, city or town, whose name has been
3 placed on the civil service list by the civil service com-
4 mission and who is suspended or discharged for no fault
5 of his own shall not lose his rating for a period of five
6 years from the date of his suspension or discharge, and
7 during that period he may be transferred from employ-
8 ment in any municipality or county to the employ of the
9 commonwealth or from the employment of the common-
10 wealth to the employment of any municipality or county
11 without any examination or other action on the part of
12 the civil service commission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
