Bill accompanying the petition of the Board of Police for the city of Fall River relative to the salary of the clerk of said board. Cities. January 13.

AN ACT

Relative to the Salary of the Clerk of the Board of Police
for the City of Fall River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the board of
2 police for the city of Fall River shall be fifteen hun-
3 dred dollars a year, to be so allowed from the first day
4 of January in the current year.

1 SECTION 2. All fees received by said clerk under the
2 provisions of section ten of chapter one hundred of the
3 Revised Laws and any other statute now in force or
4 hereafter enacted shall be paid to said city.

1 SECTION 3. Section one of chapter one hundred and
2 eighty-two of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 eleven is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
