Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for appointment as police officer, Kenneth E. Holway shall be eligible to take the next open competitive examination for appointment to the position of police officer and, provided he meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for certification and appointment.

Chap. 377. AN ACT AUTHORIZING LARRY E. WRIGHT TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR THE POSITION OF POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize Larry E. Wright to take an examination for police officer, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience. _____

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for appointment as a police officer, Larry E. Wright of the city known as the town of Agawam shall be eligible to take the next open competitive examination for the position of police officer and, provided he meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for certification and appointment.
