

HOUSE No. 618

Bill accompanying the petition of John H. McAllister relative to the completion of the state highway in the town of New Marlborough. Roads and Bridges. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Completion of the State Highway in the
Town of New Marlborough.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts highway commission
2 is hereby authorized to expend the sum of ten thousand
3 dollars during the present year for the purpose of com-
4 pleting the construction and improvement of the said
5 highway in the town of New Marlborough provided for
6 in chapter seven hundred and fifty-four of the acts of
7 the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.

1 SECTION 2. The cost and expense incurred under the
2 provisions of this chapter shall be borne in the same
3 proportion as provided in said chapter seven hundred
4 and fifty-four.

1 SECTION 3. For the purpose of meeting the expenses
2 to be borne by the county of Berkshire under the pro-
3 visions of this act, said county is hereby authorized to
4 borrow such sums as are necessary to pay its share of the
5 expenses to be incurred under the provisions of this
6 statute in the same manner as provided in chapter seven
7 hundred and fifty-four.
