Bill accompanying the petition of Louis La Dame that the pension of John O'Neil of North Adams be increased. Ways and Means. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

To increase the Pension of John O'Neil of North Adams.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The amount of the annual pension, paid
2 in accordance with the provisions of chapter fourteen of
3 the resolves of the year nineteen hundred and twelve,
4 to John O'Neil of North Adams for the loss of his leg
5 as the result of an injury received in the course of his
6 employment by the commonwealth, is hereby increased
7 to the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid
8 in equal quarterly instalments during his natural life,
9 and to be so allowed from the first day of January in the
10 current year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
