AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Representation of the Commonwealth at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of sixty-nine thousand dol-
2 lars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary
4 revenue, to be expended by the board of Panama-
5 Pacific managers under the direction of the gov-
6 ernor and council for the representation of the
7 commonwealth at the Panama-Pacific international
8 exposition, during the year ending November thir-
9 tieth, nineteen hundred and fifteen, the same to be
10 in addition to any amount heretofore appropriated.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
