

Bill accompanying the petition of John Holland and others relative to the election by the towns of Rochester, Wareham and Carver of committees to control the taking of alewives in the Weweantit river. Towns. January 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Election by the Towns of Rochester, Wareham and Carver of Committees to regulate the taking of Alewives in Weweantit River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The committees chosen by the towns
2 of Rochester, Wareham and Carver to act jointly
3 in selling at public auction the privilege of taking
4 alewives in the Weweantit river in the county of
5 Plymouth in pursuance of chapter sixty-nine of the
6 acts of the year seventeen hundred and ninety-
7 seven, approved March first, seventeen hundred
8 and ninety-eight, shall hereafter be elected by the
9 said towns at their annual town meetings, and the
10 members of the committee shall be nominated and
11 elected in the same manner in which other town
12 officers are nominated and elected.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
