

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 440, 441, 442.

Chap. 440. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF CERTAIN RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITIES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 551 of the acts of 1982 is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

Section 2. The provisions of section twenty-four A of chapter sixteen of the General Laws shall not apply to an owner or operator of a resource recovery facility who had, prior to October thirteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, negotiated agreements containing arrangements relating to real estate taxes or assessments with a city or town in which the facility is located. Said section twenty-four A shall apply upon termination of said arrangements.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of December twenty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

Chap. 441. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING AND KEEPING OF DOGS IN THE TOWN OF LONGMEADOW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one hundred and forty-seven of chapter one hundred and forty of the General Laws or any other provision of law to the contrary, all money received for licenses or from the sale of dog licenses by the town of Longmeadow or recovered as fines or penalties by said town under the provisions of said chapter one hundred and forty relating to dogs, shall be paid into the treasury of said town and shall not thereafter be paid over by the town treasurer to Hampden county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 442. AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF WESTPORT AS THE NORMAND EDWARD FONTAINE BRIDGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

ACTS, 1983. - Chap. 443, 444.

SECTION 1. The bridge over the east branch of the Westport River on state highway route 88 in the town of Westport shall be known and designated as the Normand Edward Fontaine bridge, in memory of Specialist Fourth Class, Normand Edward Fontaine, who was killed while a member of the armed forces of the United States during the Vietnam campaign. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the department of public works.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 443. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SANDWICH TO ISSUE THREE ADDITIONAL LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the town of Sandwich is hereby authorized to issue to Sandwich Package Store, Inc., Meeting-house Package and Variety Store, Inc., and to East Sandwich Package Store in said town, in each instance, a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said licenses shall be subject to all the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except said section seventeen; provided, however, that the number of seasonal licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises authorized for said town to issue under the provisions of said section seventeen is reduced by three such licenses; and provided, further, that said licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the licenses issued herein within one year after the date of issuance of said licenses.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
