AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the Commission on Economy and Efficiency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 salaries and expenses of the commission on econ-
5 omy and efficiency for the fiscal year ending on the
6 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
7 fifteen, to wit:—

8 For the salaries of the members of the commis-
9 sion, a sum not exceeding fourteen thousand dol-
10 lars. (Acts 1912, ch. 719, sect. 1; 1914, ch. 698.)

(Appropriation 1914, \$10,130, — part of year.)

11 For the salaries of the secretary, experts, clerks,
12 and other assistants, and for such other expenses
13 as may be deemed necessary and proper, a sum not
14 exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars. (Acts
15 1912, ch. 719, sect. 2.)

(Appropriation 1914, \$25,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
