Bill accompanying the petition of Harris Katz and others relative to an additional subway station on Boylston street in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the Establishment of an Additional Subway Station on Boylston Street in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Boston transit commission are hereby
2 authorized and directed to forthwith construct an ad-
3 ditional subway station on Boylston street in the city
4 of Boston at or near the block bounded by Fairfield street,
5 Boylston street and Gloucester street, with suitable exits
6 and entrances thereto, and properly connected with the
7 so called Boylston street subway, and for the use of
8 people desiring to take or leave any of the cars travelling
9 in said subway, such cars to make a stop for such purpose
10 at said station.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
