Bill accompanying the petition of the Salem and Beverly Water Supply Board relative to diverting the waters of the Ipswich river and to the installation of measuring and recording devices in said river. Water Supply. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

Relative to diverting the Waters of the Ipswich River and to the installing of Measuring and Recording Devices by the Salem and Beverly Water Supply Board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Salem and Beverly Water Sup-
2 ply Board may take and divert the waters of the
3 Ipswich river and its tributaries at any point
4 designated by the state department of health be-
5 tween the Newburyport turnpike and a point one
6 thousand feet easterly of the bridge of the New-
7 buryport branch of the Boston and Maine Railroad
8 over the said river; and the measuring and record-

9 ing devices referred to in the last sentence of sec-
10 tion four of said act may be located at such point
11 or points as the state department of health may
12 designate in the Ipswich river, or in the canal
13 across Wenham swamp from the Ipswich river to
14 the upland at the southeasterly edge of the swamp,
15 for which lands have been taken by the said board,
16 and which the said board is about to construct for
17 the diversion of the waters of said river to Wen-
18 ham lake, or at the pumping station about to be
19 constructed by said board for said purpose at the
20 southeasterly end of said canal.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
