

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 459, 460.

Chap. 459. AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 20A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 746 of the acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences:- Said notice must be made in triplicate and one copy shall be affixed securely to the motor vehicle and shall contain, but shall not be limited to, the following information: the make, color, registration number and state of issuance of said registration number of the vehicle involved. The date, time and place of the violation, the specific violation charged and if a meter violation, the number of said meter, the name and badge number of the officer and his division, a schedule of established fines, instructions for the return of the notice, and a notice which reads as follows: This notice may be returned by mail, personally, or by an authorized person.

SECTION 2. The third paragraph of section 20A½ of said chapter 90, as amended by section 6A of said chapter 746, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences:- Said tag shall be affixed securely to the motor vehicle and shall contain, but shall not be limited to the following information: the make, color and registration number of the vehicle involved and the state of issuance of the said registration number. The date, time and place of the violation, the specific violation charged and if a meter violation, the number of said meter, the name and badge number of the officer and his division, a schedule of established fines, instructions for the return of the tag and a notice which reads: This notice may be returned by mail, personally, or by an authorized person.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of July thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-three; provided, however, that any violation notices already in print, or on order, as of said July thirty-first may be issued and shall be valid notwithstanding failure to contain the information required by section one or section two of this act.

Chap. 460. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF WATER AND SEWER COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF WARE TO REGULATE THE TOWN'S SEWER SYSTEM.

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 461, 462.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The second sentence of section 10 of chapter 75 of the acts of 1963, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 473 of the acts of 1982, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the word "thirteen A" and inserting in place thereof the word: - twelve A.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of December nineteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

Chap. 461. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSURE OF HOSPITALS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 51 of chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the third paragraph, as amended by section 1 of chapter 868 of the acts of 1977, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

No original license shall be issued to establish a hospital, except a college and school infirmary, unless it complies with the construction standards of the state building code, is of at least type 1-B fireproof construction, and, except for a school building shall have been constructed for the purpose.

Chap. 462. AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE EXPENSES INCURRED BY HOSPITALS FOR LABOR DISPUTES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 31 of chapter 6A of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 372 of the acts of 1982, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the word "seventy-two" and inserting in place thereof the word:- seventy-three.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 6A is hereby further amended by adding the following section:-

Section 73. Rates of payment to be made by a third-party payor to acute hospitals as defined in section thirty-one under
