## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Holding of Evening Examinations by the Civil Service Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Upon the written request and five days  
2 notice of an applicant, the civil service commission shall  
3 hold an examination in the evening of the day for which  
4 the examination is scheduled: *provided, however,* that  
5 nothing contained in this act shall interfere with the  
6 rights of applicants to be examined at day.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
