

Bill accompanying the petition of Albert Holway for the protection of the public from injury from motor vehicles. Roads and Bridges. January 22.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Operation of Motor Vehicles when approaching Other Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fourteen of chapter five hundred and thirty-
2 four of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine,
3 as amended by section five of chapter six hundred and
4 five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and ten and
5 by chapter one hundred and ninety of the acts of the
6 year nineteen hundred and fourteen, is hereby further
7 amended by striking out the words "approaching or",
8 in the twelfth line, — and by striking out the words
9 "shall slow down and if it be necessary for the safety
10 of the public he", in the fifteenth and sixteenth lines, —
11 so that the sentence in which these words occur will read
12 as follows: — In passing a car of a street railway which
13 has been stopped to allow passengers to alight or embark,
14 the operator of every motor vehicle shall bring said
15 vehicle to a full stop.
