

ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 543, 544.

Chap. 543. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ISSUE AN ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CLUB LICENSE TO THE SAVIN HILL YACHT CLUB.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of the licenses to be issued under the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing board of the city of Boston is hereby authorized to issue to the Savin Hill Yacht Club of the Dorchester district of said city, an annual seven day all alcoholic beverage club license; provided, however, that all other provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight shall apply; and, provided further, that said licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other person, organization, corporation, or location.

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Chap. 544. AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NURSING HOME OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 19A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following nine sections:-

Section 27. For the purpose of sections twenty-seven to thirty-six, inclusive, the following words and terms shall, unless the context requires otherwise, have the following meanings:-

"Act", any action or decision made by an owner, employee or agent of a long term care facility, or by a government agency or any condition within a long term care facility which affects the provision of service to a resident therein.

"Long term care facility", any facility subject to licensure by the department of public health pursuant to the provisions of section seventy-one of chapter one hundred and eleven.

"Resident", any person who is receiving treatment or care in long term care facility including, but not limited to, application or admission, retention, confinement, commitment, period of residence, transfer, discharge and instances directly related to such status.

"Designee", a member of the staff of the state nursing home ombudsman or any director of a local nursing home ombudsman program; provided, however, that said directors have been certified by the state nursing home ombudsman, as hereinafter defined.
