

ACTS, 1983. - Chap. 550.

SECTION 1. The city of Gardner is hereby authorized to grant to Sophie E. Leblanc, widow of Edgar Leblanc, a former member of the police department of said city, an annuity under the provisions of section ninety-five of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws in the amount of nine hundred dollars per year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 550. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HOPEDALE TO APPOINT A TOWN ADMINISTRATOR.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The board of selectmen and the board of water and sewer commissioners, meeting in joint session of the town of Hopedale, acting for and in behalf of said town, is hereby authorized to appoint a town administrator for a term of one, three, or five years, and to enter into a contract with such individual for services as town administrator. The town administrator appointed under the provisions of this act shall be sworn to the faithful performance of his duties. Said town administrator shall receive such compensation as the selectmen and water and sewer commissioners may determine. Compensation for said position shall be equally divided between the general government budget under the control of the board of selectmen and the water and sewer budgets under the control of the water and sewer commissioners. Said town administrator shall act by and for the board of selectmen and the board of water and sewer commissioners in any matter under their respective supervision and control as the respective board may deem appropriate, and may perform such duties as may be requested by any other town office, board, committee, or commission. Said town administrator shall hold no elective town office, but may be appointed by the board of selectmen to any other town office or position consistent with the office of town administrator.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections twenty and twenty-one A of chapter two hundred and sixty-eight A of the General Laws, incumbent members of the board of selectmen in office on the effective date of this act shall be eligible for appointment to the position of town administrator provided (1) said appointment shall be made at a duly called joint meeting of the boards of selectmen, water and sewer commissioners, (2) any selectman applying for the position shall not participate in the

appointment process, and (3) the appointment of a selectman to the position shall not be effective until the town clerk has received a letter of resignation from said selectman as a member of the board of selectmen.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 551. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO SELL AND CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately sell and convey a certain parcel of land in the city of Boston, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience. _____

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The division of capital planning and operations is hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the commonwealth, to sell and convey by quitclaim deed, approved as to form by the attorney general, a certain parcel of land located on St. Thomas More Drive in the city of Boston under the control of the metropolitan district commission and presently used for water supply purposes, subject to the provisions of chapter seven of the General Laws and any additional terms and conditions as the division of capital planning and operations may prescribe in consultation with the commission. Said land is shown on a plan on file in said commission being bound and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the easterly corner of said parcel of land;

Thence running S15°-13'-10"W a distance of 87.02 feet;

Thence turning and running N74°-47'-00"W a distance of 222.10 feet;

Thence turning and running N00°-13'-00"E a distance of 64.00 feet;

Thence turning and running S74°-47'-00"E a distance of 121.72 feet;

Thence turning and running N64°-43'-32"E a distance of 48.68 feet;
