SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 551. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO SELL AND CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately sell and convey a certain parcel of land in the city of Boston, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience. _____

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The division of capital planning and operations is hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the commonwealth, to sell and convey by quitclaim deed, approved as to form by the attorney general, a certain parcel of land located on St. Thomas More Drive in the city of Boston under the control of the metropolitan district commission and presently used for water supply purposes, subject to the provisions of chapter seven of the General Laws and any additional terms and conditions as the division of capital planning and operations may prescribe in consultation with the commission. Said land is shown on a plan on file in said commission being bound and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the easterly corner of said parcel of land;

Thence running S15°-13'-10"W a distance of 87.02 feet;

Thence turning and running N74°-47'-00"W a distance of 222.10 feet;

Thence turning and running N00°-13'-00"E a distance of 64.00 feet;

Thence turning and running S74°-47'-00"E a distance of 121.72 feet;

Thence turning and running N64°-43'-32"E a distance of 48.68 feet;

Thence turning and running S70°-12'-19"E a distance of 80.19 feet to the point of the beginning;

Containing 17,097 square feet of land as shown on a plan entitled "Plan of Metropolitan District Commission Land located on St. Thomas More Drive in the City of Boston", by Harry R. Feldman, Inc., scale 1" = 40', dated October 27, 1983.

SECTION 2. No blasting or drilling that could in any way affect the integrity of the water tunnels and pipes located on adjacent property of the metropolitan district commission shall be allowed.

SECTION 3. The division of capital planning and operations shall comply with all provisions of chapter five hundred and seventy-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty in the sale and conveyance herein authorized.

Chap. 552. AN ACT MAKING CHANGES IN THE LAW GOVERNING THE LICENSING OF PIPEFITTERS AND REFRIGERATION TECHNICIANS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10A of chapter 22 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 34 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two paragraphs:-

Each appointive member of the bureau shall be paid fifty dollars for each day while engaged in the actual performance of his duties as such; provided, however, that such payment shall not exceed seven hundred and fifty dollars in the aggregate in any fiscal year; and provided further, that such member shall also receive from the commonwealth all expenses necessarily incurred by him in connection with his official duties.

There shall be an executive secretary of the bureau, who shall assist the members in their responsibilities. Such clerical, technical and other assistants required by the bureau shall be assigned by the commissioner.

SECTION 2. Chapter 146 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 81, inserted by chapter 990 of the acts of 1977, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
