Chap. 555. AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROTECTORS OF THE
BLIND TO BE USED IN PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 12 of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in section 112 of chapter 329 of the acts of 1980, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- Products assembled, manufactured or otherwise produced by the Massachusetts Commission for the Blind shall be purchased from the commission pursuant to the provisions of section one hundred and thirty-four of chapter six.

Chap. 556. AN ACT DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL
PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO CONVEY A
CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF
SPRINGFIELD TO THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The division of capital planning and operations acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth, as provided for in section forty F of chapter seven of the General Laws, is hereby authorized to convey to the United States, by deed approved as to form by the attorney general, all rights, title and interest of the commonwealth in and to the following parcel of land located in the city of Springfield under the control of the board of regents of higher education bounded and described as follows:-

A certain piece or parcel of land situated in the City of Springfield, County of Hampden, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, more particularly described as follows:-

Beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of State Street, extended, and the easterly line of Byers Street, extended; thence along the easterly line of Byers Street by a bearing of N. 49° 30' 30" W. a distance of 35.00 feet to the true point of beginning;

Thence along the easterly line of Byers Street by a bearing of N. 49° 30' 30" W. a distance of 50.00 feet to a point;

Thence along lands formerly of the City of Springfield, now of the United States of America, by a bearing of N. 42° 55' 30" E. a distance of 378.79 feet to a point;

Thence along land formerly of the City of Springfield now of the United States of America, by a curve to the left the radius of which is 123.85 feet and central angle is 76° 25' 40" an arc
