Bill accompanying the fourth recommendation of the Police Commissioner for the City of Boston (see House, No. 53). Judiciary (Joint). January 9.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To provide a Penalty for interrupting, molesting, insulting or obstructing a Police Officer while in Performance of Duty.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Whoever interrupts, molests or insults by abusive
- 2 words or behavior, or obstructs any police officer while
- 3 on duty or in the performance of his duty shall be pun-
- 4 ished by imprisonment for not more than six months or
- 5 by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars.
