In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

Relative to Horned Pout and Yellow Perch.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to
2 take or have in possession horned pouts or yellow perch
3 taken from the waters of this commonwealth exceeding
4 in number in any one day.

1 SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful to take or have in
2 possession horned pouts taken from the waters of this
3 commonwealth between the first day of May and the
4 thirtieth day of June, inclusive.

1 SECTION 3. Whoever violates any provision of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten
3 dollars for each fish unlawfully taken or in possession.
