

HOUSE No. 171

Bill accompanying the petition of Frank E. Clark and others for the incorporation of The Wright Home for Young Women in the city of Northampton. Mercantile Affairs. January 9.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To incorporate The Wright Home for Young Women.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Frank E. Clark and Louis L. Campbell,
2 both of Northampton, and John R. Callahan of Hadley,
3 all in Hampshire county, the trustees surviving, named
4 in the will of Henrietta M. Wright, late of said North-
5 ampton, deceased, and their associates and successors,
6 are hereby made a corporation by and under the name
7 The Wright Home for Young Women, the same to be
8 established in said Northampton, for the purpose of
9 carrying into effect and administering the trusts and pur-
10 poses declared in said last will and testament, and said
11 corporation shall have and exercise all the rights, powers
12 and privileges and be subject to all laws now or hereafter
13 in force relating to such corporations.

1 SECTION 2. Said corporation shall have power to
2 elect or appoint such officers and employees as from
3 time to time it may deem expedient. It may adopt by-
4 laws and establish needful regulations and do all things
5 deemed necessary or expedient to carry out the provisions
6 and objects of said will.

1 SECTION 3. The number of corporate members shall
2 never be less than three nor more than seven. Any
3 additional members or any successor to said trustees may
4 be elected at any meeting of the trustees by ballot.

1 SECTION 4. Said corporation is hereby authorized to
2 receive from Frank E. Clark, the surviving executor of
3 said will of Henrietta M. Wright, all the property accu-
4 ing to said trust on the settlement of his final account
5 and to take title to the real estate which is a part of said
6 trust as completely as they might if appointed trustees
7 in the probate court.

1 SECTION 5. Said corporation is authorized to receive
2 and acquire other real and personal estate by gift, grant,
3 devise or bequest for like purposes.
