## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

To provide for the Pensioning of Foremen, Inspectors, Drawtenders, Assistant Drawtenders and Storekeepers in the Employ of Cities and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The term laborer as used in chapter five hundred and  
2 three of the acts of nineteen hundred and twelve, as  
3 amended by chapter forty-seven of the General Acts of  
4 nineteen hundred and fifteen and by chapter twenty-one  
5 of the general acts of nineteen hundred and nineteen,  
6 providing for the pensioning of laborers in the employ of  
7 cities and towns shall include foremen, inspectors, draw-  
8 tenders, assistant drawtenders and storekeepers in said  
9 employ.
