Bill accompanying the petition of the selectmen of the towns of Duxbury and Marshfield that the maintenance and care of Gurnet bridge in the town of Duxbury be assumed by the county of Plymouth. Roads and Bridges. January 12.

AN ACT

Relative to the Maintenance and Care of Gurnet Bridge in the Town of Duxbury.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The maintenance and care of the bridge
2 located in Duxbury, known as Gurnet bridge, built pur-
3 suant to the provisions of chapter three hundred and one
4 of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven and
5 amendments thereto, shall hereafter be assumed and the
6 expense of maintaining the said bridge and keeping the
7 same in repair shall be paid by the county of Plymouth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
