

HOUSE No. 245

Bill accompanying the petition of M. A. O'Brien for the establishment of a bureau to settle industrial disputes. State Administration. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To establish a Bureau to settle Industrial Disputes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Be it enacted that an unpaid commission
2 be appointed by the governor to consider ways and means
3 whereby a bureau be established with broad powers and
4 to be under the department of labor and industries, whose
5 duty it shall be to settle any dispute which may arise
6 from time to time between employer and employee in the
7 commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This commission shall make its report
2 with such recommendations as it may consider neces-
3 sary for the carrying out of the purposes of section one
4 before April first, nineteen hundred and twenty.

1 SECTION 3. This act is to become effective upon its
2 passage.
