## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

### AN ACT

To provide for the Construction by the Metropolitan District Commission of a Boulevard from the City of Melrose to the Town of Saugus.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to take land and con-  
3 struct and maintain a boulevard as a part of the park  
4 system from Bellevue avenue in the city of Melrose  
5 toward Lynn woods, and for this purpose the commis-  
6 sion may expend a sum not exceeding fifty thousand  
7 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. To meet the expenses incurred hereunder,  
2 the treasurer and receiver general is hereby authorized to  
3 issue, in the name and behalf of the commonwealth,

4 bonds to the amount of thirty thousand dollars, as an  
5 addition to the Metropolitan Parks Loan, Series Two.  
6 The bonds shall be issued in such amounts and upon such  
7 terms, and shall bear such rate of interest, not exceeding  
8 four per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and  
9 shall be paid serially in such amounts and at such times,  
10 within a period not exceeding forty years, as shall be  
11 determined by the treasurer and receiver general, with  
12 the approval of the governor and council, to be for the  
13 best interests of the commonwealth.
