

Bill accompanying the petition of Edward J. Wade and others for an increase in the salaries of the mayor and aldermen of the city of Lawrence. Cities. January 15.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To increase the Salary of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Lawrence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section fifty-two of Part II of chapter six
2 hundred and twenty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred
3 and eleven is hereby amended by striking out the words
4 "thirty-five hundred", in the first and second lines, and
5 substituting the words:— five thousand, — and by strik-
6 ing out the words "twenty-five", in the fourth line, and
7 substituting the word:— thirty-five, — so as to read as
8 follows:— *Section 52.* The salary of the mayor shall be
9 five thousand dollars per annum, and the salary of each
10 of the remaining four members of the city council shall be
11 thirty-five hundred dollars per annum. These salaries
12 shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by the mayor and city council of the city of Law-
3 rence.

The following report of the Commissioners of the Land Office in response to a resolution passed by the House of Representatives on May 18, 1875, is hereby published for the information of the public.

The report contains a detailed account of the operations of the Land Office during the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1875. It also contains a statement of the assets and liabilities of the Office, and a statement of the amount of money received and expended during the year.

The report is divided into two parts. The first part contains a general statement of the operations of the Office, and the second part contains a detailed statement of the operations of the Office in each of the several States and Territories.

The report is published in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress, approved on the 18th day of May, 1875, and is hereby published for the information of the public.
