

HOUSE No. 412

Bill accompanying the petition of Joseph L. Whiton, mayor, for the establishment of a board of license commissioners in the city of Quincy. Cities. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

Establishing a Board of License Commissioners in the City of Quincy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established in the city of
2 Quincy a board of license commissioners to consist of the
3 city clerk of said city and the chiefs of the police and fire
4 departments of said city.

1 SECTION 2. All authority to grant licenses and permits
2 and except as hereinafter provided to suspend and revoke
3 the same now or hereafter vested by law in the mayor
4 and city council of said city and in the mayors and city
5 councils and boards of aldermen of cities of the common-
6 wealth, except the authority to grant licenses for the sale
7 and transportation of intoxicating liquors and permits to

8 public service corporations for location in the streets and
9 ways of the city for any purpose, shall be hereafter exer-
10 cised in said board of license commissioners exclusively.

1 SECTION 3. The city council of said city shall retain
2 all authority it now possesses or may be hereafter granted
3 to it to establish ordinances relating to the manner in
4 which the holder of any such license and permit may
5 exercise the right granted thereunder. Said board of
6 license commissioners shall not establish any rules or
7 regulations relating to such licenses and permits incon-
8 sistent with the provisions of any law of the common-
9 wealth or any ordinance of the city of Quincy.

1 SECTION 4. The mayor of the city of Quincy may sus-
2 pend any license or permit granted or issued by said
3 board of license commissioners for a period of not exceed-
4 ing thirty days in any one calendar year without assign-
5 ing any cause therefor and without giving the holder
6 thereof a hearing by filing a written notice to that effect
7 in the office of the city clerk of said city.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
