chauffeurs and laborers in connection with any work undertaken for the rehabilitation, remodeling and expansion of said library.

SECTION 3. The net proceeds of any sale authorized in section one shall be deposited in a special account in the stabilization fund of said town and shall not be withdrawn from said fund for any purpose other than to repurchase the said property except by a two-thirds vote adopted at two separate town meetings held at least six months apart, at least one of which shall be an annual town meeting. Any income from moneys held in said special account or any rent payable to the town may be deemed general revenues of the town and deposited from time to time with the town treasurer.

SECTION 4. Except as provided in sections two and three, actions by or on behalf of the town authorized by this act shall be taken by the board of selectmen.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 639. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HOLDEN TO PERMIT THE LATE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR STATUTORY DEFERRAL OF A CERTAIN BETTERMENT ASSESSMENT.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirteen B of chapter eighty of the General Laws, or any other law to the contrary, the town of Holden is hereby authorized to permit the late submission by Clifford L. Adams and Gunhilde Adams of an application for statutory deferral of betterment assessment in accordance with said section thirteen B of said chapter eighty with regard to real estate owned by said Clifford L. Adams and Gunhilde Adams at 268 Parker avenue, in said town, as shown on assessor's map 215 as parcel 17 and to grant said applicants such deferral if they are eligible therefor and to repay any portion of said betterment assessment which may have been paid and is eligible for such deferral.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
