AN ACT

Relating to the Competency of Witnesses to Wills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. A will of any person dying after this act
- 2 takes effect shall not be invalid by reason of the incompe-
- 3 tency of any attesting witness thereto who is not dis-
- 4 qualified by insufficiency of understanding.
- 1 Section 2. Section twenty-three of chapter one hun-
- 2 dred and seventy-five of the Revised Laws is repealed.
- 1 Section 3. Nothing herein contained shall affect the
- 2 provisions of section three of chapter one hundred and
- 3 thirty-five of the Revised Laws regarding a devise or
- 4 legacy to a subscribing witness or to his or her hus-
- 5 band or wife.
