AN ACT

Relative to the Payment of Certain Compensation to
George Goodfellow of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay to George Goodfellow, formerly in the employ of
3 the Boston transit commission, the difference between
4 the sum which he received while in the service of the
5 United States government and the amount which he
6 would have received had he continued in the employ of
7 the Boston transit commission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the city council of said city with the approval
3 of the mayor, provided that such acceptance occurs prior
4 to September first, nineteen hundred and twenty.
