RESOLUTION

Rescinding the Ratification of the General Court of the proposed Eighteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

1 *Whereas*, The general court of nineteen hundred and
2 eighteen passed in the house of representatives March
3 twenty-sixth, and, in concurrence, in the senate, certain
4 resolutions ratifying a proposed amendment to the con-
5 stitution of the United States relative to intoxicating
6 liquors, and

7 *Whereas*, It appears that said ratification was not in
8 conformity to the will or belief of the people of the
9 commonwealth, be it

10 *Resolved*, That said resolutions ratifying said proposed
11 amendment to the constitution of the United States
12 relative to intoxicating liquors be and hereby are re-
13 scinded and repealed.
