

HOUSE No. 784

Bill accompanying the petition of Eden K. Bowser that penalties be provided for violations of motor vehicle traffic laws and ordinances. Joint Judiciary. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

Providing Penalties for Violations of Motor Vehicle Traffic Laws or Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The operator of a motor vehicle shall upon
2 conviction of violation of any motor vehicle or traffic law
3 or ordinance present to the clerk of the court in which
4 the judgment is rendered his license as an operator of
5 a motor vehicle, and said clerk shall endorse on said
6 license in brief the nature of the violation and the date
7 of the conviction and if an appeal is taken a notation
8 thereof. If the appellate court shall find said operator
9 not guilty the clerk of the appellate court shall endorse
10 in brief on said license that finding.

1 SECTION 2. Any operator who refuses or neglects to
 2 present to the clerk his license as above provided shall
 3 be liable to a fine of not more than fifty dollars, and the
 4 fact of such refusal or neglect shall be reported to the
 5 department of public works by said clerk and said de-
 6 partment may suspend or revoke said license as it shall
 7 determine.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

in the Year of the Lord 1919

AN ACT

Relating to the Regulation of Motor Vehicle Traffic
 Laws in Operation

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
 in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
 same, January 15, 1920.

Chapter 90B, Section 2. Any operator who refuses or neglects to present to the clerk his license as above provided shall be liable to a fine of not more than fifty dollars, and the fact of such refusal or neglect shall be reported to the department of public works by said clerk and said department may suspend or revoke said license as it shall determine.
