Bill accompanying the petition of Daniel J. Marshall for an amendment of the law relative to the special poll tax assessed to furnish funds for granting bonuses to soldiers and sailors. Taxation. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

Relative to the Special Poll Tax levied on account of the Bonus given to Veteran Soldiers and Sailors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of Part I of chapter four hundred and
2 ninety of the acts of nineteen hundred and nine, as
3 amended by section ten of chapter two hundred and
4 eighty-three of the General Acts of nineteen hundred and
5 nineteen, is hereby amended by striking out the said
6 section and substituting the following:— *Section 1.*
7 In and for the seven years beginning with the year nine-
8 teen hundred and twenty, a poll tax of three dollars shall
9 be assessed on every male inhabitant of the common-
10 wealth above the age of twenty years whether a citizen
11 of the United States or an alien.
