AN ACT

Relative to Cinematographs and Similar Apparatus operated with Cellulose Acetate Films and an Enclosed Incandescent Lamp.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The provisions of chapter seven hundred and ninety-
2 one of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen
3 shall not apply to any cinematograph or similar apparatus
4 that is so constructed that it cannot use films of the
5 size and perforation used in standard theatrical cine-
6 matographs, and that is operated with only cellulose
7 acetate films and with only an enclosed incandescent
8 lamp.
