## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Treasurer and Receiver General to pay to the Dependents or Heirs-at-law of George A. Kennedy a Gratuity of One Hundred Dollars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer and receiver general is here-  
2 by authorized to pay to the dependents or heirs-at-law of  
3 George A. Kennedy, late of Lynn, a resident of Massa-  
4 chusetts, who served in the army of the United States dur-  
5 ing the war with Germany, and who was killed while in  
6 the service of the army of the United States, and while on  
7 furlough, the sum of one hundred dollars as a gratuity in  
8 accordance with the spirit and intent of chapter two hun-  
9 dred and eighty-three of the General Acts of nineteen  
10 hundred and nineteen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
