AN ACT

Relative to Sentences to the State Farm.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 A person who has committed an offence punishable by
2 imprisonment in a house of correction, may, on convic-
3 tion, be sentenced to the state farm, and all laws relative
4 to sentences, commitments to, and discharges therefrom,
5 shall apply in cases arising under this act.
