

**ACTS, 1983. - Chaps. 713, 714.**

and all other things reasonably necessary for the laying out, relocation and construction of University avenue as well as the laying out, relocation and construction of Everett street as shown on said plan referred to in section seven of this act.

SECTION 7. The parcels A,B,C,D,E, and 8 referred to hereinafter are those shown on the plan being a part of the "Petition of John F. Kinnaly and others, petitioners for the relocation of Everett Street, American Drive and University Avenue, Norwood, Massachusetts", which petition was received by said county commissioners on September 14, 1981, under Docket No. 1700.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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**Chap. 713. RELATIVE TO THE INTERMENT OF CERTAIN PERSONS.**

Be it enacted etc., as follows:

Section 38 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 697 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:-

Said commission shall provide for the burial expenses, up to three hundred dollars, for the remains of any person whose previously unknown grave has been disturbed, forcing its relocation, and whose identity has been determined by the state archaeologist to be that of an American Indian.

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**Chap. 714. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF ADMINISTRATION TO SET FEES AND CHARGES PAID TO THE COMMONWEALTH.**

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the Commissioner of Administration to set fees and charges paid to the Commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

ACTS, 1983. - Chap. 715.

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 572 of the acts of 1980 or any other general or special law to the contrary, the commissioner of administration shall, not less than thirty days prior to setting any new fees and or charges, provide public notice of any increase in the fees to be charged by the commonwealth for each service of any kind performed by any state personnel or agency and shall consider any and all written comments received and shall conduct a public hearing on any proposed increase in said fees and/or charges.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 572, as amended by Section 2 of chapter 602 of the acts of 1982, is further amended by striking out section 417 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 417. This act shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of said chapter 572, any subsequent increase made in accordance with the provisions of said chapter 572 in the amount charged for professional or occupational licensure, registration, regulation permit or other public function performed by state personnel shall not be applicable to any person 65 years of age or older on or after the effective date of this act.

SECTION 4. The last paragraph of section 3B of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as amended by section 1 of said chapter 602 is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the words: "December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-three" and inserting in place thereof the words:- "June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eighty-five."

SECTION 5. Said chapter 572, as amended by said chapter 602, is hereby further amended by adding the following section:-

Section 417B. In no instance shall a fee or charge set by the secretary of administration under the provisions of this section exceed the fee or charge in effect on the effective date of this section, unless it is reported to, and approved by a vote of a general court.
