## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Revere to borrow Money for Sewer Purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Revere, for the purpose of  
2 constructing main sewers and drains, may borrow a sum  
3 not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars in excess of  
4 the statutory limit of indebtedness, and may issue bonds  
5 or notes therefor, said bonds or notes to bear on their  
6 face the words "Revere Sewer Loan, Acts of 1920," and  
7 to bear such rates of interest as may be fixed by the  
8 city treasurer with the approval of the mayor. Said  
9 bonds or notes shall be issued in compliance with the re-  
10 quirements of chapter seven hundred and nineteen of the  
11 acts of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and  
12 amendments thereto, in so far as applicable to sewer  
13 loans. Each authorized issue of such bonds or notes  
14 shall constitute a separate loan. Premiums received on  
15 loans herein authorized shall be used as provided by  
16 general law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
