RESOLVE

Directing the Department of Public Utilities to Investigate and Report on the Expediency of a Service Charge by Gas and Electric Light Companies.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public utilities is
2 hereby directed to inquire into the expediency and neces-
3 sity of permitting a service charge to be made by gas and
4 electric light companies doing business in the common-
5 wealth. The said department is hereby directed to
6 pursue such investigation as it may deem necessary, and
7 to report its findings, together with legislation, if any be
8 necessary thereon, to the next general court on the first
9 Wednesday in January.
