AN ACT

To authorize the Trustees of the Massachusetts Hospital School to acquire Additional Land in the Town of Canton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of the Massachusetts hospital
2 school are hereby authorized, subject to the approval of
3 the governor and council, to purchase or take by right of
4 eminent domain in the name and in behalf of the com-
5 monwealth, the land and any structures thereon assessed
6 to Helen M. Tolman, Bradford W. Cobb, George Fisher,
7 Elisha White, John Everett and James Cose, a total of
8 not less than ninety acres, which is situated in the town
9 of Canton adjoining or in the neighborhood of the land of
10 the commonwealth which is used for the said school.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the pro-
2 visions of this act the sum of fifteen thousand dollars
3 shall be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the com-
4 monwealth.
